

HTE GeNiUS 2021 - FAQ

FAQ ALL

Which is the required commitment?

AS an HTE GeNiUS participant, you must take part in the seminars, and schedule a few hours of teamwork every week, in order to progress with your project.

Is there a certificate at the end of the course?

Yes, there is a certificate of attendance at the end of the course. You must attend the seminars in order to get the certificate; the attendance will be monitored at each seminar by the Teachers.

Is there a prize for the winning project?

Yes, HTE's partner **Talent Garden Genova** provides a prize for the winning team consisting in 3-months of Flex Membership (coworking desk for 20 hours a week) in both campus in Genoa (Talent Garden Genova Erzelli, Talent Garden Genova Baltimora) for each member of the team. Specific networking and consulting opportunities will be provided to the winning team tailored to their needs.

How long does the program last?

The program lasts 8 weeks, from October 22nd to December 16th.

My English level is B1, can I take part in the program?

Both the courses and the teamwork will be held entirely in English, given the presence of international students and IIT researchers. The students should be proficient enough to understand the courses and manage the interaction with the partners.

How will the seminars be structured?

The seminars consist of 50% in vertical teaching and 50% of teamwork.

How will the teams be structured?

Each team is assigned to a different technology. Each team is made up of the researchers owning the tech idea, and from three students with various backgrounds, who come from UCA and UNIGE.

If I have an idea for a start-up, can I present it at the course?

No, such an initiative is not included in the program. The goal of HTE is to start from existing technologies to develop business opportunities.

Are travels refunded?

Yes, accommodations and buses will be paid for by the University.

Does the course have to be included in the Study Plan?

Yes, it must be part of the Study Plan. The course is worth 6 CFU while no grades are provided for it.

What knowledge is required to participate?

Basic knowledge from Accounting, Management Control, Finance, Marketing and Business Organization courses is sufficient to bring value to the process of writing the Business Plan for Tech IIT Projects.

Do I need previous knowledge or competence in technology-related fields?

Applicants do not need to possess technical competencies of any sort. We welcome students from any background since we believe external perspectives are crucial to developing an innovative service.

Students receive the “Bonus entrepreneuriat” (+0,25 to their overall score) and a certificate of participation issued by the Istituto Italiano di Tecnologia.

How many travels to Italy are planned for HTE?

Currently, we have planned two trips to Genoa; one trip is for the official kick-off, on 22nd of October, from 3 pm to 7 pm with the possibility to spend the night in Genoa. The second trip to Genoa is scheduled for the final HTE GeNiUS event, on 16th of December. We plan to arrange a bus for both trips. Please consider that travel plans may vary according to the pandemic evolution.
